

2010 IRVINE JUNIOR GAMES

On Sunday, May 16, 2010, at Irvine Stadium, located behind Irvine High School, 1,400 fourth through eighth grade IUSD athletes will again show their spirit during Irvine's 23rd Annual Junior Games event. The Junior Games is a family fundraising event for the Irvine Children's Fund, a nonprofit organization supporting the Irvine Child Care Project in cooperation with the Irvine Unified School District. The money raised by the Irvine Junior Games is used to help meet the before and after school child care needs on IUSD elementary school sites and to provide child care scholarships.

Event Day Details

Athlete Check In will be on Saturday, May 15 from 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. and Sunday, May 16 beginning at 9:00 a.m. Athlete T-shirts will be distributed at check-in and must be worn to compete. **ATHLETES NOT REGISTERED THROUGH THEIR SCHOOL MAY NOT COMPETE.**

Tickets will be on sale during the Saturday athlete check-in on and at the gate on May 16th. Adults - \$8.00 Children - \$2.00

Food and Drinks will be on sale the entire day

Opening Ceremony will begin promptly at 9:45 a.m. All athletes are expected to participate and should be lined up on the track behind their school's banner with their school by 9:30 A.M.

Track and Field Rules

Shoes: Any rubber track shoe is acceptable with the exception of metal cleats or spikes. Shoes that accept metal spikes or cleats are acceptable so long as the metal elements have been removed. Soccer-style shoes are not required for the "soccer kick" field event but are permitted. There is an athlete only seating area for each school.

IRVINE CHILDREN'S FUND

Irvine Children's Fund is a nonprofit community support organization whose mission is to raise funds, primarily through the Irvine Junior Games and grants, to support before and after school child care on IUSD school sites.

ICF has contributed:

- \$1,157,126 for child care scholarships
- \$230,928 to maintain existing child care facilities and fund new facilities located on Irvine school sites
- \$137,606 for athletic equipment and to schools and teachers participating in the Irvine Junior Games
- \$82,800 to the child care sites to fund activities and to purchase supplies and equipment

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Students in 4th, 5th and 6th grades may select **one** sprint, **one** distance and **one** field event.

Sprint Events are limited to 4 girls and 4 boys per grade 4th through 6th, per school. Runoffs to determine the entrants in these events will be conducted at your child's school. Distance and Field events are open to any IUSD student in 4th through 8th grade - no eliminations.

4th Grade Students

Sprint - 50 **or** 100 meter sprint
Distance - 400 meter run
Field - soccer kick, **or** bag shot **or** standing long jump **or** basketball shoot

5th and 6th Grade Students

Sprint - 50 **or** 100 meter sprint
Distance - 400 **or** 800 meter run
Field - soccer kick, **or** bag shot, **or** standing long jump **or** basketball shoot

7th and 8th Grade Students

7th and 8th graders may sign up to participate in **all** sprint, distance and field events as listed below.

Sprint - 100 meter sprint
Distance - 400, 800 **and/or** 1500 meter
Field - soccer kick, running long jump, **and/or** basketball shoot

Relays will be run by sex and grade with 4 girls and 4 boys from each grade per school. Individual schools will determine the entrants for this event.

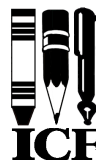
